1 Corinthians 15: 1 – 8

15 Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. ² By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain. ³ For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that he appeared to Cephas, and then to the Twelve. ⁶ After that, he appeared to more than five hundred of the brothers and sisters at the same time, most of whom are still living, though some have fallen asleep. ⁷ Then he appeared to James, then to all the apostles, ⁸ and last of all he appeared to me also, as to one abnormally born.

**Dear WRCS Community
(and supporting congregations),**
At the meeting with patrons 4/29/2019, those in attendance rallied in support of the school. One of our patrons volunteered to organize a campaign to raise the funds needed to keep WRCS open for another year or two. The Board feels this will allow time to strategically plan for our future with a vision and financial sustainability. The amount needed to be raised is \$1 million based on an enrollment of 80 or more students. \$500,000 needs to be raised no later than May 30. Once the \$500,000 is raised the Board will approach the School Council for reconsideration of the decision to close the School.
