

A message from Pastor John and the Worship Commission:

The theme for Lent this year, as provided by the Mennonite Church USA Worship Writing Team, is entitled, "Deep Calls to Deep". Through the scriptures that we will be exploring, the team suggests that we are called to identify "what is essential, what really matters, who we are at our core, and what God asks... of us." As in Psalm 42:7, we are called to go deeper.

Each week as we are called to go deeper, there will be a response activity related to that week's theme. The response activity will involve six stones and some sort of container in which you can store those stones. The stones and the container should be close to you each week when logged into Zoom worship. Each week you will be asked to remove a stone from the container and write a word on the stone reflecting that morning's challenge to go deeper.

So, what the Worship Commission is asking each person to do is collect six stones before the first Sunday of Lent (which is February 21), have the stones stored in some sort of container, and have a felt tip pen with which to write on the stone.

Also, please note that there will be no Ash Wednesday service this year, but the commission is busy planning a Good Friday service which we are certain will be enjoyed by all.
